Consultant Ms Hwa Yu and researcher Brian Hobbs on historical context of RDP MoU

Biographies:

- Hwa Yu is a consultant to U.S. and international clients on offsets, industrial cooperation, and Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC). Her Security Cooperation expertise comes from working for 15 years in the Joint U.S. Military Affairs Group-Korea (JUSMAG-K), within the U.S. embassy in Seoul. She served as the Defense Acquisition Program Administration (DAPA) liaison for U.S. and Korean governments regarding foreign military sales related matters.
- Brian Hobbs is a PhD candidate at Virginia Tech, expecting Fall 2024 completion. He has an M.A. in National Security Affairs, a B.A. (double major) in psychology and East Asian languages & cultures, and proficiency in Japanese, Korean, and Chinese. As a U.S. Air Force Foreign Area Officer, he taught at the U.S. Air Force Academy and Korea Air Force Academy, and managed FMS cases at Air Force International Affairs (SAF/IA). Since leaving active duty, Security Cooperation expertise includes working in DSCA, at the F-35 Joint Program Office, in industry, and as the senior author for three DSCU case studies.
- Hwa and Brian have been collaborating on Defense Security Cooperation University (DSCU)'s FMS book chapter regarding RDP MOUs, with the title of "*Reciprocal Procurement: Securing Supply Chain Partners*," which is expected to be published early next year. This presentation is an outcome of that joint research. On October 28, during the DSCU hosted Security Cooperation Conference, Hwa and Brian will present RDP and offsets as panelists at different panels respectively.
- Back in July, they jointly published an article in Korean news media discussing RDP MOU status in the Republic of Korea.
